Explore the cultures, animals and habitats in 7 continents!**

Montessori Mornings—Geography, history, language, math and science come alive with hands-on multi-sensory discovery and learning

Arts in the Afternoon—Arts, crafts, sewing, drama, cooking, music and dance from cultures around the world make this international tour *fun-tastic!*

Join us for this awesome summer adventure around the world!

Week 1, July 5 - 7 **North America, Part 1**

Our summer-long journey around the world begins with the countries of North America—Canada, USA, and Mexico. Embarking from Maryland, in their first week, they will “Go West” to find the spectacular North American landscape—gigantic mountains, lakes, rivers and plains-- and explore Native American cultures through arts, crafts, music and dance.

Week 2, July 10 - 14 **North America, Part 2**

Children will “Head South” to learn about the people and cultures in Mexico and Central America. The children will learn how to make corn tortillas from scratch, and how to do the Mexican hat dance! We will practice our Spanish, sing songs in Spanish and learn new words—like ‘una fiesta!’ which means PARTY and we will end our week with una fiesta grande!

Week 3, July 17 - 21 **South America**

Our South American exploration takes us to the Amazon River & Rainforest and the gigantic Andes mountains. Children will learn about Peruvian culture, life in the forest and life in the mountains—and what is “Machu-Picchu”, anyways? They will make jewelry from clay beads that they have created and painted themselves, and practice their Spanish some more.

Week 4, July 24 - 28 **Africa**

Children will learn about the varied landscape of Africa—the enormous mountains, the expansive grasslands, and the vast deserts and how people live there—can people live in the desert? We will find out! Children will also explore the animals and plants of the varied biomes on the island of Madagascar, including a Madagascar “Move it, Move it!!” party.

Week 5, July 31 – August 4 **Europe**

Our European adventure will include learning about a very special kind of home found all over Europe—castles! Who lives in these castles? Children will explore village life in Europe, with a focus on Italy. This exciting week will conclude with a mini-Scottish Highland Games!

Week 6, August 7 - 11 **Asia, Part 1**

Far, far away in the country of India is a vast and ancient culture, which the children will explore through art, music, and language. We will also experiment with making salt from salt water!

Week 7, August 14 - 18 **Asia, Part 2**

Oh, so adorable! Panda bears will fascinate children as they learn about their habitats in the mountains and bamboo forests of China. Did you know that, in China, people use worms to make their clothing? The life cycle of a silkworm is so interesting to children!

Week 8, August 21 - 25 **Australia**

Children will learn about some wild and wacky animals from Australia – like the kangaroo and platypus—and who lives in the Great Barrier Reef? Australia’s fascinating topography is home to many cultures, and children will explore Aboriginal culture and arts.

Week 9, August 28 –31 **Antarctica**

And don’t forget Antarctica! Polar Ice and penguins are really COOL! The children will enjoy this deep-freeze exploration, and then complete their voyage around the world with an international flag parade and festival—fun times!

The 2017 Summer Camp Program at Frederick Country Day, for children ages 3-6 years, runs continuously from July 5th – August 31st. Full-time enrollment will take priority, and space is limited. Come and enroll soon!

- ❖ A deposit of \$25 per child per week **is due by May 19th.**
- ❖ The deposit secures a place for summer camp and is applied toward tuition.
- ❖ The deposit is non-refundable under any circumstances and will be credited to the last week's tuition payment.
- ❖ Additional fees will be charged as necessary throughout the summer for special activities and events (moon bounce, animal show, etc.) Permission slips will be sent home the week prior to the event.

Tuition payment is due 2 weeks in advance of the camp week your child is enrolled in. For example, if your child is attending the first week of camp, tuition payment (less the prepaid \$25 deposit) is due Monday, June 21st, 2017.
