Outreach: Gently used books for Hagerstown Social Services – we focus our needs to children without access to books and resources for home.

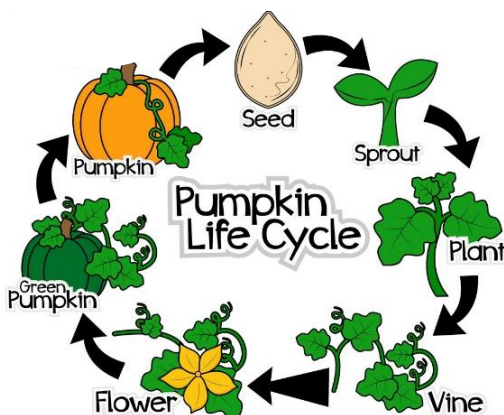
