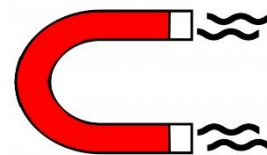
OUTREACH: GENTLY USED WINTER COATS, SCARVES, HATS, & MITTENS FOR FAMILIES IN NEED - Glade Valley

Art focuses on Cezanne and many of his still life works. Look for how that might integrate into science and culture's curriculum of Brazil and Bolivia. Our Music curriculum focuses on Composer Ludwig Van Beethoven.

Room Update: In the month of November Room 1 will be learning about Thanksgiving. We will read the First Thanksgiving by Jack Prelutsky. We will read about the Pilgrims and Indians We will explore our science area by working with



magnets. Children will be doing simple science activities with magnets which are fun, easy to use and common. They will be placing the item in the correct tray that is labeled 'magnetic' or 'non-magnetic'. Children will be learning about **South America**. They will explore the continent by learning about its climate, people, language, food and its culture. We will be learning about **Brazil** and the **Amazon Rainforest**. We will learn about the different layers of Rainforest, the animals found there and the types of plants that grow there. Children will be making **Maracas** and **rainstick instrument** for the art and craft. We will talk about Diwali the "Festival of Lights" celebrated in India.
